## 2012 IOWA TRACK & FIELD CLINIC SPEAKERS

### MARCUS NEWSOM

Wartburg College Track and Field Head Coach

In his 13-year tenure at Wartburg, Marcus Newsom has coached 100 indoor and 178 outdoor Division III All-American performances, and 33 individual events have earned national championship titles. His success has not gone unnoticed as he has garnered eight Division III National Coach of the Year awards, including both the 2012 Indoor and Outdoor Women's Coach of the Year honors. In addition, Newsom has received 28 conference coach of the year awards. On the national level outdoors, the women have finished in the top 15 at nationals in 10 of Newsom's 13 years as head coach, including winning national titles in 2005 and 2009. On the

national level indoors, Newsom's teams have finished in the top 20 of seven women's team races, which includes back-to-back national championships in 2009 and 2010, and have placed in the top 20 three times in the men's team race. In 2009, his women's teams became only the seventh team in NCAA Division III history to sweep indoor and outdoor national titles in the same season, and set new all-time meet records in team points in both meets.

### RICK McGUIRE

University of Missouri

Dr. Rick McGuire is the Director of Sport Psychology for Intercollegiate Athletics at the University of Missouri, and Graduate Professor of Sport Psychology in the Department of Educational, School and Counseling Psychology. For 27 years he was Missouri's Head Track and Field Coach. Under McGuire's tutelage, Missouri athletes earned 143 All American honors, 110 conference championships, 29 USA National Team memberships, seven NCAA Championships, set three collegiate records, and earned five Olympic berths, resulting in two Olympic Silver Medals. He is the founder, and chairman for 27 years, of the USA Track and Field Sport Psychology program, and served on the staff for 11 USATF National Teams, including the 1992 and 1996 Olympic Games. McGuire also served as President of the NCAA Division 1 Track and Field Coaches in the United States Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association.

### DAN GREEN

Woodlawn (TX) High School Head Coach

Two-time National Cross Country Coach of the year, Dan Green, has built a dynasty in distance running in Texas. As Head Track and Cross Country coach at the Woodlands High School, his teams have made 30 consecutive appearances at State Cross Country meets. His runners have won 16 State Championships and multiple individual State Titles in his 33 year tenure. A University of Houston Track Alumni, Green is USA Track and Field level II certified and has been selected as head coach of two US National teams.

## 2012 IOWA TRACK & FIELD CLINIC SPEAKERS

### VINCE ANDERSON

Texas A&M Assistant Coach

Vince Anderson has trained All-American athletes in every sprint, hurdle and relay discipline, as well as the long jump. Prior to his arrival in College Station, Anderson coached at the University of Tennessee for 16 years. While at Tennessee he coached 11 individuals to SEC titles and his athletes set 26 school records. During his stint in Knoxville, the Vols earned the NCAA outdoor title in 2001, the NCAA indoor title in 2002 and also won the elusive Southeastern Conference outdoor championships back-to-back in 2001 and 2002. For two years, Anderson had the good fortune to be Justin Gatlin's college coach. Among his many notable achievements as a college trackster, Gatlin swept both the 100 and 200 meter dashes at the 2001 and 2002 NCAA Outdoor Championships.

### TRAVIS GEOPFERT

University of Arkansas Assistant Coach

Since Coach Geopfert's arrival at Arkansas, the Razorback multi-event athletes have made a big splash at the SEC and NCAA levels. Under Geopfert's guidance in 2012, the Razorbacks claimed an SEC title (the first in Razorback history) in the decathlon, a new junior world record in the heptathlon, a 2012 World Junior Championship title, and one of his athletes represented the Bahamas at the 2012 Olympic Games in the long jump. In addition, Geopfert's athletes scored 37 points at the 2012 SEC Outdoor Championships, including an SEC title in the long jump and finishing 1-2-3-6 in the decathlon. In the past seven seasons, Geopfert has coached three Division I and II National Champions, 13 student-athletes to 26 All-America honors, 54 conference champions, 89 all-conference performers, 43 NCAA qualifiers, 43 NCAA outdoor regional qualifiers and 16 USA Championship qualifiers.

### LARRY JUDGE

Ball State University

Most recently, Larry Judge served as the throws coach for the 2012 United States Paralympic team in London. He coached world record holder Jeremy Campbell in the F44 discus throw who won the Gold Medal in London. Widely recognized as the premier track and field throws coach in the USA, Judge completed his collegiate coaching career with the University of Florida in 2005. Under Judge's direction, the Florida throws group reached the pinnacle of the sport amassing unparalleled honors. In just five years at UF, Judge tutored eight All-Americans, five SEC Champions and two NCAA Champions. Judge has guided eight athletes in the last three Olympic Games. Judge serves as a level II and level III instructor in the IAAF coach's education program, and was the National Chairman of the United States Track and Field Coaches Education for the Throwing Events from 1994-2011.
